Climate Change March

By three o'clock in the afternoon, Trafalgar Square <u>was swarming with people</u> and <u>buzzing with activity</u>. There was a carnival atmosphere with music provided by a samba band, a New Orleans jazz band and Scottish pipers.

Most protesters marched peacefully, but a small group of people <u>broke away from</u> the peaceful demonstrators. They smashed shop windows and tried to set fire to a supermarket. Five people were arrested.
