Imagine that your classmates and you are doing a school project on tourism. You have collected some photographs from a holiday brochure. Now you are going to discuss the questions given below to include the following information in the project:

- 1. What attracts tourists to places like these (given in the photos below)?
- 2. In which two places can tourists cause the most harm? What kind of harm can be caused by tourists (2-3 ideas)?
- 3. How can tourists benefit visiting the places? Give reasons to support your point of view? (2-3 benefits)
- 4. Is it better to visit the places on your own or as part of a package tour? Give reasons to support your idea? (2-3 reasons)
- Make a conclusion.



The number of pupils who are taking part in the discussion is 5 people. The discussion lasts for about 5-10 minutes. You are supposed to prepare for the discussion in a group. The time for preparation is limited by 15 minutes.

One of the students in the group is a moderator. He or she is going to lead the discussion. His/her role is to ask the questions, express his/her point of view and make a conclusion at the end of the discussion.

The other 4 students are the participants in the discussion. They come up with their ideas. While discussing the ideas, use the phrases expressing your choice and reasons. While reacting to your classmates' ideas, use the phrases to agree or disagree with them.
