Part II. 3 min

I: In this part of the competition I'm going to give each of you two photographs. I'd like you to talk about your photographs on your own for about 1 minutes and also to answer a short question about your partner's photographs.

I'd like you to compare the two photographs and say **why it might be important for the people to learn these new skills**.

(Candidate 2) _____, look at your partner's photographs and say **"Do you find it difficult to teach someone a new skill? And why?"**

(Candidate 1) _____, here are your photographs. They show people spending time together. I'd like you to compare the two photographs and say **why these types of relationships are important to all of us**.

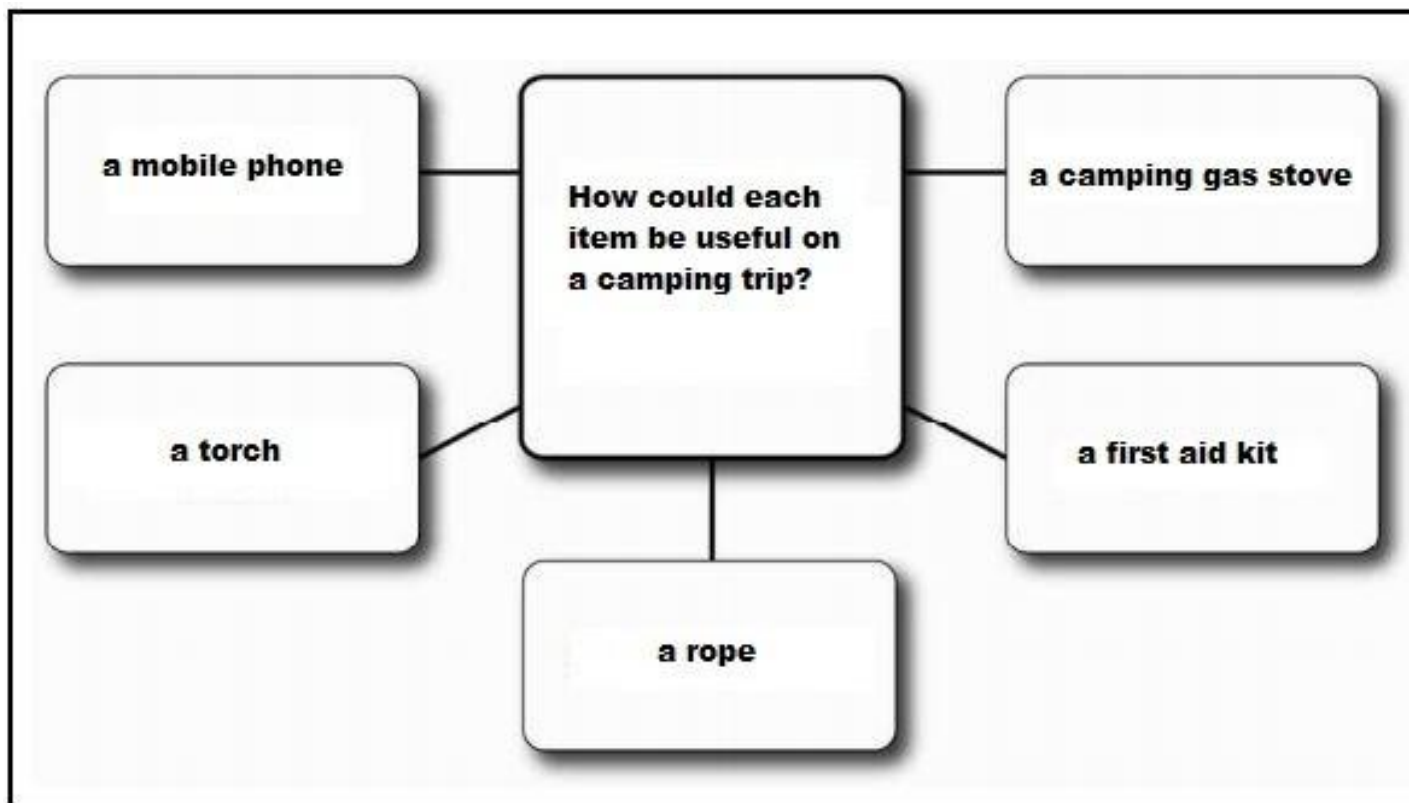
All right?
