READING (20 points)

REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE

Everybody buys and uses a variety of products every day without giving it a lot of thought. Each of these products affects the environment somehow; through the way it is made, used or disposed of. For this reason, eco-scientists are trying to come up with ideas to introduce environmentally friendly products into our lives. Their motto is REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE!

- (1) For most people, doing the laundry is neither an enjoyable chore nor an easy one. That's why it's left to washing machines and dryers. These appliances, however, are not as environmentally friendly as one might think. Soon, you will be able to buy clothes that don't need to be washed or, at least, don't need to be washed as often. In one case, material that repels dirt has been invented. So, instead of washing that shirt you're wearing, you can clean it by wiping it with a wet cloth. Another idea involves introducing specially-engineered bacteria into the material. What would that do? The bacteria would 'eat' odour-causing chemicals and sweat and leave you with a clean shirt! Brilliant or what?
- (2) The sun is an endless source of energy. Now there is a way to both capture and use that energy wherever you go. The Solar/Electronic Backpack is a stylish accessory designed to charge portable electronic devices. Solar panels on the outside of the backpack capture the sun's energy and use it to power a battery. Then, all you have to do is plug your mobile phone or MP3 player into the battery and it will be charged. Worrying about cloudy skies? Don't! The battery on the backpack can also be charged by using electricity.
- (3) The device which is thrown out most frequently is the mobile phone. Eager to keep up with all the latest technology and trends, consumers tend to throw out their phones after an average of 18 months and buy the latest model. But this results in mountains of unwanted phones, taking into consideration that about two billion mobiles are in use worldwide. For this reason, researchers in England created a phone with high-tech materials. What's so special about it? Well, it contains a sunflower seed. When you don't want the phone any longer, you simply plant it. The seed grows into a sunflower, fertilized by the biodegradable case, which will break down completely within a month. If that isn't environmentally friendly, what is?
- (4) Plastic bags are convenient for shoppers, but they are difficult to dispose of since they harm the environment. It takes 1,000 years for a plastic bag to break down, and when buried, they contaminate the soil. So, what can we do with them? Well, in Delhi, India, plastic bags are being transformed into fashionable handbags. Workers collect the bags, clean them and sort them by colour. European and Indian designers then use the plastic to create handbags in the latest designs. This process not only recycles an unwanted product, but it also helps support some of the poorest people in Delhi.


