Вам предстоит выполнить письменные задания муниципального этапа всероссийской олимпиады школьников по английскому языку. Время выполнения заданий письменного тура — **90 минут**. Максимальная оценка за правильное выполнение заданий письменного тура — **60 баллов**.

Выполнение заданий целесообразно организовать следующим образом:

- внимательно прочитайте формулировку задания;
- напишите правильный вариант ответа в листе ответов;
- после выполнения всех заданий ещё раз удостоверьтесь в правильности Ваших ответов;
- если потребуется корректировка ответа, то неправильный вариант ответа зачеркните и рядом напишите новый.

Ответы должны быть занесены в листы ответов чёрными гелевыми или капиллярными ручками. Проверке подлежат только листы ответов.

При оценке тестовых заданий, где необходимо определить один правильный ответ, 0 баллов выставляется за неверный ответ и в случае, если отмечены несколько ответов или все ответы (в том числе правильный).

Задания письменного тура считаются выполненными, если Вы вовремя сдаёте их на проверку.

Во время выполнения заданий письменного тура запрещено:

- общаться с другими участниками олимпиады;
- указывать персональные данные, делать случайные пометки или рисовать на листах ответов;

(A) Like the author, the hero is a sailor and laborer. His strength and intellectual curiosity lead him to educate himself. He becomes a writer, expressing his view of life. When one of his books makes him rich and famous, his former fiancée tries to start their relationships again, but his love is killed when he understands that she only admires his fame and financial success.

B The main character is the narrator of the story. A tomboy who does not care much about clothes or appearance, the character appears thoughtless and temperamental at first. However, the character is also intelligent and can make logical conclusions and connect the events in a proper way. Curiosity, intelligence, and the inborn feeling of right and wrong are inherited from Mr Atticus, the character's father, who is a lawyer in a small American town.

C The hero's true identity is hidden from the reader until the end of the book. Having no parents, the hero is raised in a workhouse, then runs away and is forced to become a pickpocket. Even when treated badly, the hero is kind to everybody, honest, and quick to forgive.

- **D** A first-year student, this character with bushy brown hair, large teeth and a bossy voice seems to be an annoying perfectionist, a 'know-it-all' who has read all the school books in advance and never breaks the rules. The character's desire to impress with knowledge and to stand out stems from the fear not to fit in with the other students or to be left behind.
- E Sleeping on doorsteps when the weather is good and eating whatever it is possible to get, the protagonist is homeless and uneducated. This carefree life without norms or rules is what makes the other children in the village admire the protagonist. This freedom gives the protagonist a chance to observe the environment and give realistic descriptions of the Mississippi River and the culture of the nearby towns.
- **F** Being the oldest child in the family, the 16-year-old protagonist is responsible, kind and loving. The family is poor, with three other children and a father away from home. The protagonist helps to run the household and to look after the children, but is also dreamy and has a small weakness for luxury and leisure.
